




The purpose of the Growing Ministry is to develop programs and ministries that lead to growth in faith, stewardship, membership and life together as a church.



What is Your Voice? (WIYV) is a nonprofit organization that works against domestic violence, family violence, and teen dating violence. They work on stopping the cycle of violence against women and children within Sussex County and Delaware.

This includes weekends, holiday vacation days, etc. Items to consider donating


include kid-friendly, nonperishable items, such as:

- Lunch items in pop-top or easy-open containers (spaghetti, ravioli, mac-n-cheese, soup).
- Fruit or applesauce in a cup, dried fruit in a bag.
- Cereal in a cup or small box, Pop Tarts.
- Granola bars or protein bars.
- Peanut butter crackers, Goldfish, etc.
- Cookies, chips, or other snacks in small bags.
- Plastic bottle or boxes of juice.
